

AT HOME WITH A PROP STYLIST

The former apartment of prop stylist Joanna Lavén combines her affinity for effortlessly fusing the past with contemporary sensibilities. Preserving the Jugendstil character of the Stockholm apartment as much as possible, Lavén oversaw the complete renovation of the light-filled space. Many of the original details had been lost over time, taken away piece by piece by previous owners. Lavén devoted herself to restoring the space to its former glory, leaving no detail unconsidered. Mid-century furnishings, refined fixtures, and parquet flooring add to the timeless interior experience. Inspired by a classical Parisian hallway, the updated entry features a black and white checkerboard marble floor, high ceilings, and stately proportions. Rich woods, dark fabrics, and bronze finishes offset the light grey and white walls. This warmer decor keeps the residence in balance, while inviting daylight in from the generous windows that line the grand rooms.
