

Cardboard creatures to go!

Assemble a collection of cardboard creatures that will be able to join you in escapades of your own making! In no time at all, you'll be having fun with your crew of big-game animals, dangerous dinosaurs, or even awesome arachnids! Who's going to be in your gang?

You will need

- cardboard
- a pencil
- scissors
- glue
- acrylic paint or watercolors and a brush
- felt-tip pens



1 Draw the outline of your creature's body on the cardboard along with the sections for its legs and tail. Cut all the pieces out using the scissors.

2 Cut small slits in the body section where you want the legs to be attached, and cut a corresponding slit into each pair of legs. Attach the tail with glue.



3 Paint all the sections of your cardboard creature. Once the paint is dry, you can add extra features—eyes, teeth, spots, stripes, or scales—using paint or felt-tip pens.

4 Assemble your creature by sliding the extra features onto the main body section using the slits you cut into them earlier.
