



Black plywood units as space dividers

Local Sydney architect <u>Nicholas Gurney</u> designed the black-finished plywood units in this 21 m² (226 ft²) studio apartment to be assembled on site. These units subdivide the space, creating various zones: kitchen, bedroom niche, and storage area. The sleeping niche is hidden from the rest of the apartment space by a plywood unit with a sliding desk and sliding door. A high-level steel shelf mounted wall-to-wall conceals a sliding door track, which is used to support the storage unit and allows the desk to slide away seamlessly.

Top The desk and sliding door move with the aid of a sliding door track hidden by a high-level steel shelf. Above When fully extended, the desk completely conceals the bedroom niche.
