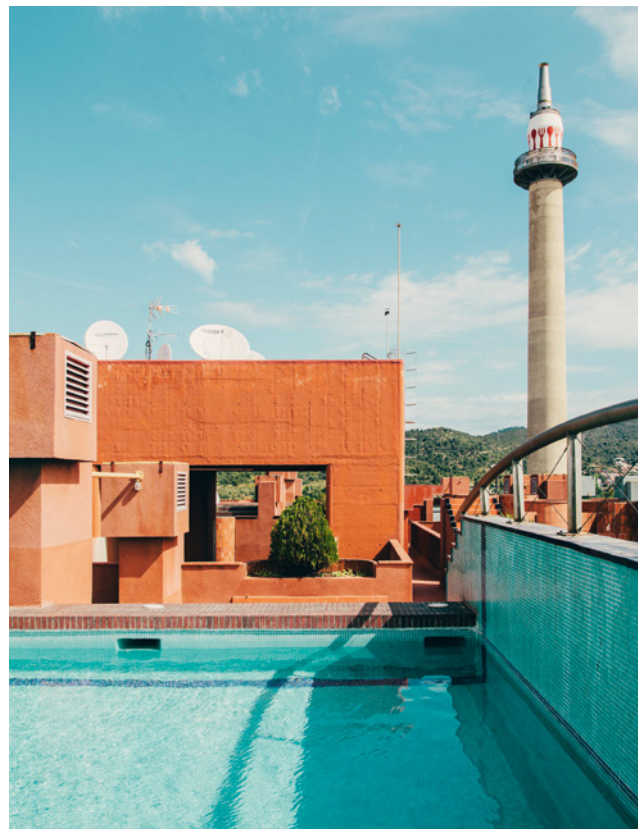
The details

Number of apartments: 446

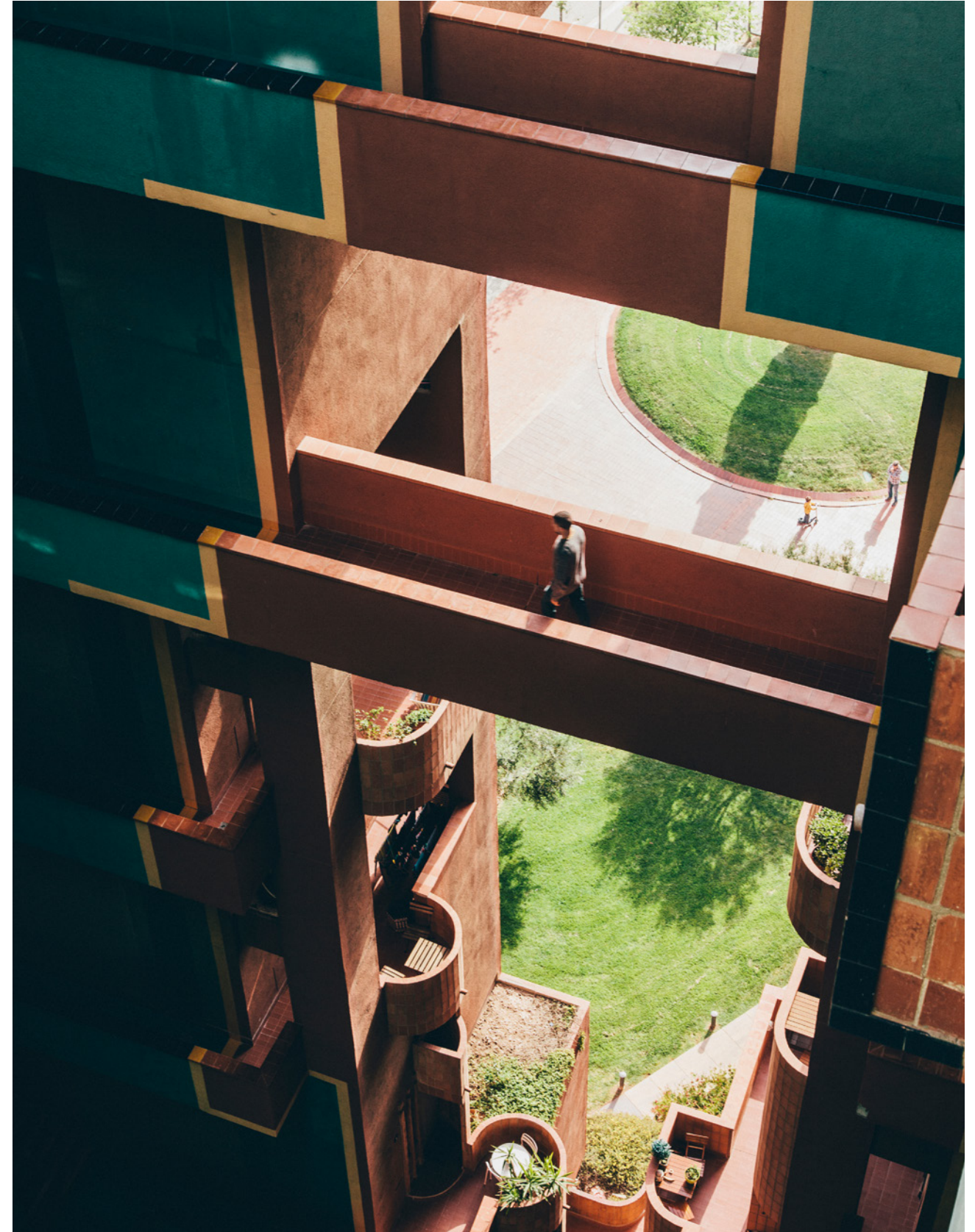
Communal facilities: Two pools, ping-pong tables, a summer cinema in the central patio and a modest library, plus a clutch of bars and shops line the exterior.
