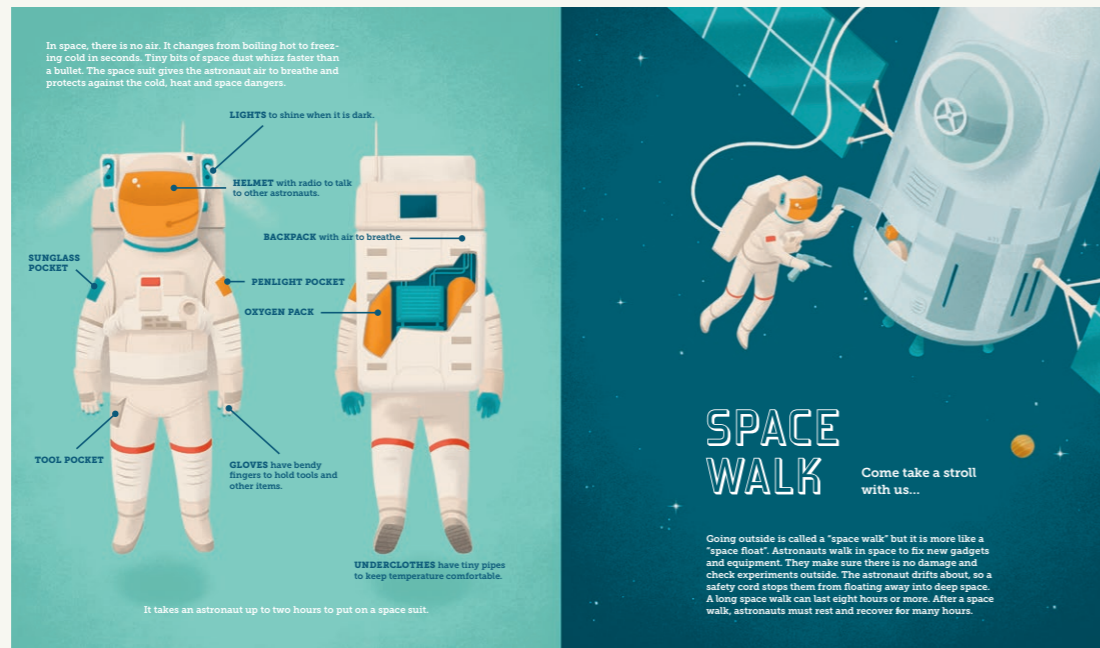

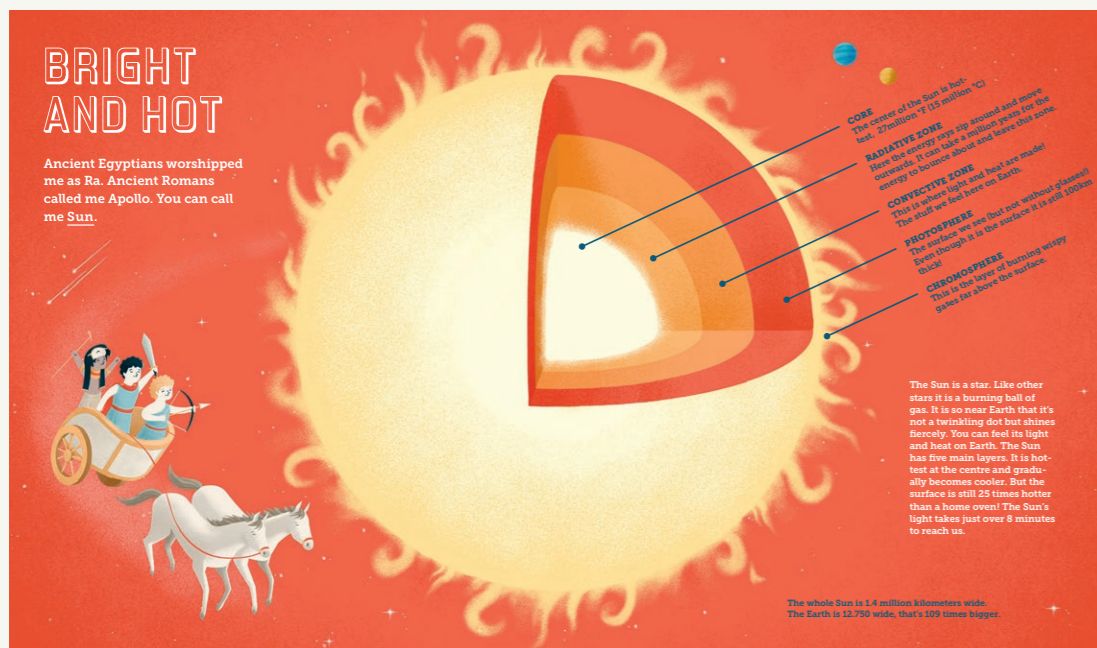
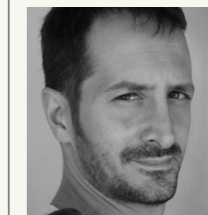

When it comes to science his formula is simple: remember the two I's, information and imagination.

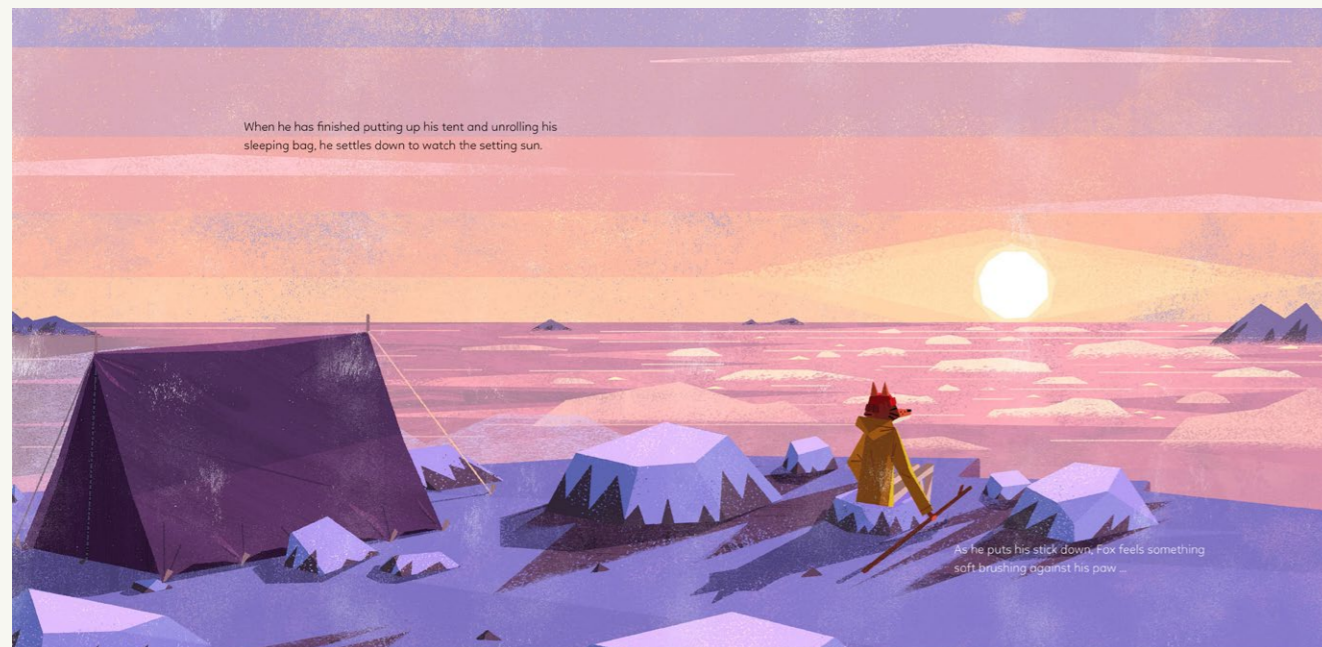

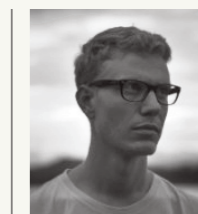
When he has finished putting up his tent and unrolling his sleeping bag, he settles down to watch the setting sun.

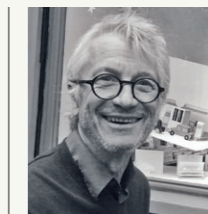

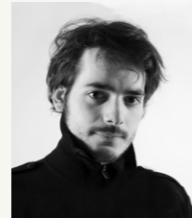


This classic Japanese fairy tale tells the story of *Issun Bôshi*, the tiny son of an old, childless couple.

Desperate for a son, an old woman adds the words “even if it is a very small one” to her wish. When she bears a son, he is only one inch high. He is called *Issun Bôshi*, Japanese for one-inch boy. One day, he realizes he will not grow. Leaving his loving home and believing himself a samurai, he takes along a needle as a sword and a soup bowl for a boat. *Issun Bôshi* is tested in several adventures and, in the end, is rewarded with the perfect princess.



ICINORI are Mayumi Otero and Raphaël Urwiller. Mayumi Otero is a French illustrator of children's books whose drawings and etchings are often playfully ironic. Her colleague Raphaël Urwiller is a graphic designer and illustrator who works for newspapers and magazines in addition to creating children's books.



Together, Otero and Urwiller designed *Issun Bôshi* in a style reminiscent of Asia.

Author and illustrator **LAURENT MOREAU** applies his unique analog approach to hand-drawn graphics and page-filling designs and creates a world where humans are the strangers and a child's sense of wonder at Mother Nature reigns.



While Iwan Bôshi was gathering logs in the forest to make a fire, all of a sudden, at a bend in the path, he came across a strange-smelling, strange-looking creature, like none he had ever seen before: gigantic, hairy, and mischievous.

The Atomium in Brussels boasts the longest escalators in Europe. *The Illustrated Atlas of Architecture and Marvelous Monuments* presents a world of breathtaking buildings and their incredible stories through illustrated maps and engaging factsheets.

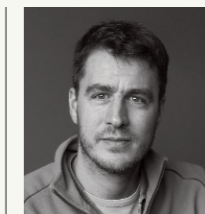

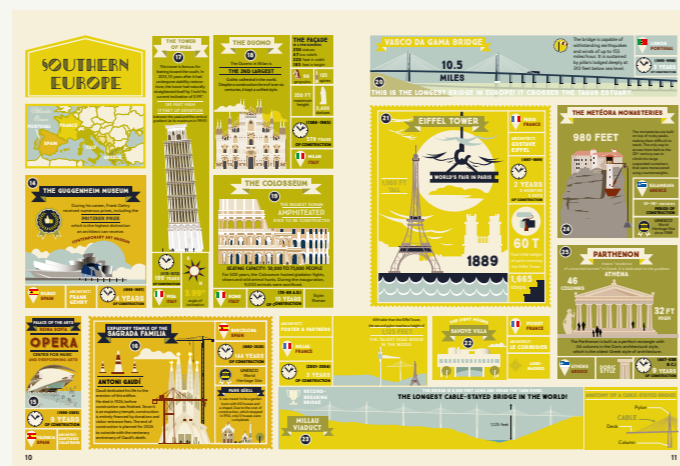
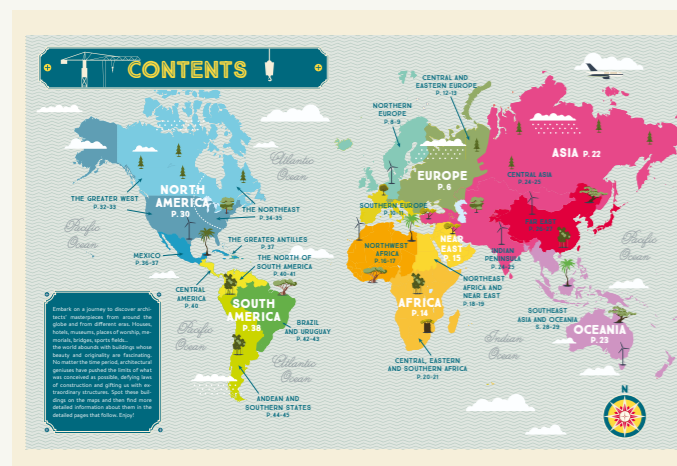
Oodles of painted images simultaneously explain daily life while welcoming readers to indulge in the details.
