

An Intimate Getaway on a Wild Swedish Island

ATRIUM HOUSE — Sweden ○ Each Nordic nation has its own traditional way of getting in touch with nature: from the Danish summerhouse to the Norwegian mountain cabin to the Finnish seaside sauna, the remote getaway is an important part of Nordic life. The Atrium House—located on the island of Gotland and designed by Stockholm-based Tham & Videgård Arkiteker—takes the getaway concept to an extreme, giving families an extraordinary opportunity to reconnect with untouched nature. While the vacation home's interior is organized around a central open-air courtyard, its outward-facing facades have large windows that provide both panoramic views of the landscape and a feeling of intimacy and shelter: precisely the right balance for a cozy wilderness hideout.
