Crowned the world's best restaurant four times since opening in 2003, Noma bases its ethos on modern Nordic fare, locally sourced and simply cooked. Wishing to introduce a similar "handmade" feel to the interior—and rising to the challenge—Thulstrup focuses on well-designed, custom-built fittings and furnishings. River stones set into terrazzo flooring and counters made from rough-hewn timbers—everything about the place exudes a natural, relaxed vibe without feeling too rustic or homey. The textured surfaces create a warmth and harmony, while the commissioned artworks and an occasional vintage piece prevent the place from looking manicured.
