

Tiny House for Tailored Living

JOHANNESBURG, SOUTH AFRICA • This prefabricated, customizable 17 m² (183 ft²) home was designed as a way to "live smaller, spend less money, and go out more often." Johannesburg-based architect Clara da Cruz Almeida prioritized flexible spaces and worked with South African designers Dokter and Misses on the interior, which is made from veneered plywood.

Multipurpose design is integral to this project: the dining table can also be a sideboard or coffee table, while foam seating turns into an ottoman, lounge chair, small mattress, or a full-size sofa. There's even a shower in the passageway, where you will find the same duckboarding used on boats. A storage box system can be easily moved between spaces and light fittings are transferrable—hung from hooks and plugged in at the wall. Bright orange flexes were chosen to make a design feature of the visible cables.
