The owners wanted a space where they could entertain friends and that they could use for work functions, as the barn was both their home and office. The barn had been extended in the 1990s, with a simple 10-meter extrusion over two floors. However, this previous extension had left the masonry barn with virtually no relation to the beautiful landscape surrounding the house. →
