

Make a Flower and Leaf Crown



You Will Need

- A stapler
- Double-sided sticky tape
- Flowers or petals
- Feathers
- Long grasses or ferns
- Twigs
- Fallen leaves
- Glue
- A measuring tape, enough card to make a headband
- Scissors

Collect fresh flowers, grasses, and fallen leaves then make a beautiful crown!

*Top tip:
Think about the design of your crown before you start.
Do you want it to be all leaves?
Or should a big flower be at the front?*

Always ask an adult's permission to pick any flowers.



1 Measure around your head using the measuring tape, then cut a piece of card to that length. It should be at least a few inches wide.



2 Using the same measurement, cut a piece of double-sided sticky tape, and carefully stick the tape along the middle of the length of the card. If you don't have sticky tape, get the glue ready.

3 Get collecting! You'll need plenty of items to cover your crown.



4 Pull off the outer layer of the tape, or place drops of glue along the length of the card, and gently but firmly place each object onto the sticky surface.

5 When you are finished, staple or glue the ends of the card together. Now you can wear your crown!
