SEB's Cafetière Filtre was futuristic, with round corners and pleasant curves. By this point, SEB had considerably improved their manufacturing techniques and were able to work with sturdy plastics that had glossy finishes. This is also one of the

earliest examples of a feature that comes as standard today: the drip stop. SEB was among the first manufacturers to introduce it, allowing the coffee pot to be removed mid-brew, the machine designed to know when to stop the flow of liquid.
