This extensive styling set came with four different types of brush attachments, a flat styling nozzle, and a small spray bottle. What differentiated it from competing products was an inbuilt mechanism allowing the dryer to swivel from 90° to 180°, giving it the two-in-one capabilities of both a classic pistol dryer and styling brush.

This functionality is neatly concealed by the bulbous orange plastic casing, with graphic diagonal lines denoting the dryer's suction inlet. Other versions of this product were available on the market with fewer attachments, including the Allround Styler 800, which was a less powerful machine.
