

A SPACE FOR DEEP CONTEMPLATION IN A SERENE OASIS WITH OAXACAN TEMPLE VIBES

Casa TO Oaxaca, Mexico



Surrounded by the greenery of a nearby ECOLOGICAL RESERVE and within easy walking distance of the BEACH, Casa TO harmonizes with its natural environment to create a HAVEN OF PEACE and tranquility.

Not far from the popular surfing resort are miniature sanctuaries—cool, calm, and of Puerto Escondido on Mexico's Pacific simply furnished. Walls are left with the coast, Casa TO is a two-story boutique hotel with just nine suites. Designed by Frenchborn, Mexico City—based architect Ludwig Godefroy, the elegant hotel is fashioned almost entirely from concrete that has been by local craftspeople, and colorful rugs and cast in situ.
