It does not get more remote than the Fljót Valley on the mountainous Troll Peninsula in northern Iceland. Located on a former sheep farm that dates back to the eighteenth-century, Deplar Farm is a unique getaway for nature lovers. Surrounded by towering snow-dusted mountains and emerald-green pastures, the farm and several thousand acres of adjoining land were acquired by Eleven Experience. However, what now lies beyond the sign is no sheep farm—the adventure-travel company set out to turn it into a luxurious rural basecamp for ski lovers, fishermen, and whale watching aficionados.
