

Grow Egg Carton Seedlings

Did you know that egg cartons make great seed trays? It's true!

You Will Need

- An egg carton
- Compost
- Parsley seeds
- Seeds
- Scissors
- A small watering can

Carefully cut off the top of the egg carton—you'll be using the bottom half of the carton (where the eggs that usually sit).

Fill each section of the egg carton with compost then add around five parsley seeds to each cup.

Cover the seeds with a bit more compost then gently and evenly water them. You could put the carton onto a plate to catch any extra water that runs off.

Place the egg carton on a windowsill that gets plenty of sun and water regularly so the soil doesn't dry out.

Soon, your seeds should sprout! They'll be ready to be replanted once they are a few centimetres tall.

To do this, simply snip off one of the cups using the scissors and place it directly into the soil in a new pot. The roots will grow through the bottom of the carton!
