Nook and Niche-Filled Farmhouse in the Hudson Valley

Rustic and romantic, this fixed-up farmhouse in the Hudson Valley, New York, is full of cozy nooks and niches with built-in furniture, original beamed ceilings, wide-planked floors, vintage finds, and modern pieces that come together in charming harmony. Tara Mangini and Percy Bright of Jersey Ice Cream Co. designed the American Revolutionary War home for a Brooklyn-based couple, and in their usual approach, they stayed in the adjoining converted barn to get a true feel for the place.

Highlights include the original hand-planed cupboards in the living room, beadboard walls in the family room where bespoke seating with storage flanks the brick-lined fireplace, storage and nooks with niches for books built by Bright from reclaimed vintage doors, drawers on both sides of a bed, and the guest bedroom lined with subtle graphic Farrow & Ball wallpaper, and a floating shelf with vintage art, tiny glass vases, and books.
