This chunky electric pocket shaver came with its own handsome carrying cassette, opening up to reveal the razor and a small mirror as well. It's an earlier example of a pocket shaver—modern in its design but still humble. The Krups 80 is the German manufacturer's answer to

Braun's Sixtant 6006, which was similar in form and also came with a storage cassette featuring an enclosed mirror. Nevertheless, the Krups 80's finishing is solid and high quality. The brand would later release orange versions under the names Flexonic II and Flexonic Junior.
