Homemade wind chimes look great when hung outside! They are easy to make from items that would otherwise be thrown away, or from natural objects collected on walks.

Carefully cut 6–8 equal lengths of string and tie them neatly to the bottom of your clothes hanger around one inch apart.

> Top tip: If you don't have a clothes hanger, you could use a stick and some string, instead.

You could make a nature-themed wind chime from pinecones, twigs, or shells or you could stick to colorful beads and buttons. It's up to you! Choose which items you would like to make up your wind chimes, then slot or tie them to the string. If you are painting any items, do this first and wait for everything to dry.
