This handsome blow-dryer was part of the same line as the Foen 500 but could easily be mistaken as a Krups or Braun product. In fact, the sturdy, glossy plastic shell is not typical of AEG, which veered more towards matte plastics. The handle

can be tilted along the axis to create better angles for easier hairstyling. AEG originally obtained a copyright for "foen," a German word for blow-dryer, meaning other brands had to get creative when naming competing hair drying products.
