“The best way of pinpointing the right look is to create a mood board,” advises Franziska Burgert. The Berlin-based designer has been designing custom bridal fashion since 2015 and is well aware of the questions that newly engaged couples are likely to be asking. “You can find a huge selection on Instagram and Pinterest by entering keywords like #weddingdress, #groomstyle, #queerwedding, or #curvybride. But make sure that you’re mainly pinning looks that suit the style and venue for your wedding!” Tip: Most places get cooler in the evening, so give some thought to a cape, a stole, or even a hoodie!
