→ Flexibility is the key to this space. Many features are adaptable, such as the rolling workbench and shelving unit. Even the raw elm desktop in Scott's office area doubles as extra kitchen and shoot space when required.



→ Power outlets in the ceiling beams allow the hanging bulbs to be moved around as needed, and the curtains are hung from brass clips, making the lighting highly customizable. Blackout blinds can be fitted to the windows when shooting too.
